



Abstract submission deadline: 2nd April 2026

In this guideline we explain how to 1) register with ScienceOpen and how to 2) submit an abstract via ScienceOpen for the upcoming “*cGMP: Generators, Effectors and Therapeutic Implications Conference*” in Kassel, Germany (2026). We describe the process step-by-step providing comprehensive screen shots and short explanations (in red letters or within red boxes).

Please read the following important information carefully before you proceed:

- 1) You will need your ORCID ID to register at ScienceOpen. If you do not have an ORCID ID you will be directed to <https://orcid.org/> during the registration to create an ID. To register at ScienceOpen and to create an ORCID ID will only take a few minutes of your time. If you are already registered at ScienceOpen you may skip pages 3 to 6, but please read all the information given on this page carefully.
- 2) Only the submitting author needs to register with ScienceOpen, but of course all authors are welcome to do so.
- 3) Upon review by the organizing committee your abstract is either declined, returned for correction or accepted. When the latter happens, your contribution will be immediately available via ScienceOpen with the **submitting author as corresponding author**. Note that no changes are possible at this stage. Respective notifications will be sent to the submitting author before May 8th, 2026.
- 4) Some abstracts will also be selected for oral presentation. In order to promote young scientists, we will usually get in touch with the **first author** (who may or may not be the corresponding author) of an abstract to offer them a slot in the program.
- 5) If questions arise or any point seems unclear to you, please contact **Prof. Adrian Hobbs** (a.j.hobbs@qmul.ac.uk).
- 6) Note that only abstracts (as poster or talk) from registered participants can be presented at the conference. Please visit our website and follow the conference registration procedure. Invited speakers must also use the tool to upload / to publish an abstract of their presentations.


